Information

- Please note that play will commence for the LD category on Friday evening from 5 pm. All other categories will start at 9am on Saturday. This will be at the discretion of the Referee and Organising committee for the event.
- Classification will take place on Friday evening from 2pm for those players who have not been classified before or who have been specifically asked to attend.
- If there are less than 5 players in any category then the organising committee have the right to "combine categories". Should this be the case, then a 'plus points' system shall be used.
- The tournament will be run under the regulations of BWF and Badminton Wales standard regulations.
- All players who participate in the event must be affiliated to one of the 4 Nation's National Governing bodies.
- All players must be a permanent resident of one of the 4 Nations.
- The coaching of players during events will follow BWF guidelines.
- PD Group games 3 sets with no extended play / semi & finals 3 sets with extended play.
- LD Group games and semi-finals 1 set with no extended play / Final 3 sets with extended play.
- Please remember that photography is only permitted at the event if you have obtained permission from the Referee. People wishing to do so may request a permit from match control.
- Players, Coaches, Officials, Parents and Volunteers shall be expected to abide by their governing bodies 'Code of Conduct'. Please ensure you refer to these conditions prior to the event.
- A cancellation fee shall also be levied at competitors who do not attend without suitable reason - A fee of £5 is payable if an entry is cancelled within 36 hours before the start of play. Full refunds will only be considered if applied for in writing within 14 days after the tournament
- Please not that in ALL situations, the Referee's decision shall be final.

Code of Conduct

The goal of **Badminton Wales** is to create a lively Sporting environment, and to promote the spirit of the game, through the exclusion of unethical behaviour, which will not be tolerated.

- 1. Treat all others as you would like to be treated, with integrity politeness and admiration.
- 2. Practice, play and spectate within the spirit of the game.
- Help each other to learn new skills.
- 4. Compete as individuals and partners
- 5. Give respect to others coaches, officials, other players, team managers, parents who help organise/ officiate and play the sport.
- 6. Accept final decisions from event referee and court umpires and officials.
- 7. Do not direct verbal, physical, emotional abuse towards opponents/coaches/umpires/partners/event organisers & other team members
- 8. Arrive 30 minutes before the start of play each day to ensure adequate preparation and to be punctual on all occasions, inform event organisers of any injuries which cause you to withdraw from matches.
- 9. Respect when officials are working and that their busy role in assisting with the event delivery may make them inaccessible at some times.
- 10. Respect that the taking of photographs is to be done only with the appropriate accreditation and at times that are appropriate during the event or highlighted by the event organisers as not disturbing competitors or officials.
